Blood Lead Level (BLL) is the amount of lead in a child's blood. A blood test is the only way to know if your child has been exposed to lead.

Even small amounts of lead are harmful. Lead poisoning can make it hard for your child to learn, pay attention and behave.

Talk to your child's doctor and have your children tested to prevent lasting harm from lead poisoning.
